

YOU CAN'T WIN A RACE

Tips for Judging Track Event Placings

01 THE TORSO TELLS THE STORY

In track events, placings are determined by when a competitor's torso reaches the finish line.

02 TOTALLY THE TORSO

The torso DOES NOT include the head, neck, arms, legs, hands or feet.

PLACE JUDGE FOCAL POINT

Place judges have to watch for the torso only to reach the finish line.
